





The 2022-2023 season marks the 10th anniversary of the **Allen Community Band**!

In September 2013, a group of musicians met at Christ the Servant Lutheran Church with the goal of forming a Community Band. We had a place to rehearse, interested musicians, a Director, but no music and no idea of the instrumentation. During this same time, we were invited to perform at Arbor Day by the Park Department and Steve Terrell, then mayor of Allen. And, of course, we said yes! Little did they know, we really did not have a Band yet.

10 years later, many of those original 30 musicians are still in the Band with membership now approaching 80. We have outgrown the Church's facility and our original performance venue, the Civic Auditorium. Rehearsals for both bands, and Concerts by the Concert Band, are now at the Lowery Ninth Grade Center Auditorium. The Jazz Band performs at the Civic Auditorium within the Allen Public Library complex on a regular basis. The Concert Season includes four formal concerts by the Concert Band, a very active Jazz Band, and several small ensembles that perform in the area throughout the year. And, yes, we still perform for Arbor Day. This would not have been possible without the support of our



Program Notes

The Star-Spangled Banner – Written by Francis Scott Key, an attorney and gifted amateur poet, while watching the British bombard Fort McHenry in Baltimore Harbor during the War of 1812. It was harmonized in 1917 by Walter Damrosch and skillfully arranged by John Philip Sousa. The Allen Community Band performs the official Department of Defense arrangement of the National Anthem.

Daughters of Texas – After an evening concert in Denton, Texas, on October 19, 1928, John Philip Sousa was approached by representatives from Texas Women's University (then the College of Industrial Arts) with a petition signed by 1,700 young women who wanted Sousa to compose a march for the school. Flattered, as he said, by "the request of seventeen hundred charming Texas girls...", he penned a march originally titled "Daughters of Denton", and subsequently renamed it the "Daughters of Texas" march. The march is now played as the recessional at all TWU graduation ceremonies.

The Phantom of the Opera – The longest-running show in Broadway history, Andrew Lloyd Webber's *The Phantom of the Opera* debuted in 1988, winning seven Tony Awards including Best Musical. Based on Gaston Leroux's horror novel, it tells the enticing story of the Phantom, who haunts the stage of the Paris Opera and subsequently falls in love with a beautiful young soprano, Christine Daaé.

Sadly, the Broadway production is scheduled to close on April 16, 2023.

Paul Murtha's arrangement features: "The Phantom of the Opera", "Angel of Music", "The Music of the Night", "All I Ask of You", "Masquerade", "The Point of No Return", and the award-nominated song composed for the 2004 movie adaptation "Learn to Be Lonely".

Program Notes

Texas Hill County Theme – This beloved Texas anthem was written for the TV documentary *Lyndon Johnson's Texas* and later recorded by the Boston Pops on their album *The Pops Goes West.* But it is most fondly remembered as the original theme from Bob Phillips' TV travelogue *Texas Country Reporter.* David Lovrien's arrangement captures the nostalgia and majesty while adding quotes from "The Yellow Rose of Texas". Donated by Troy & Denise Webre.

The Lion King – On Broadway since 1997, *The Lion King* is the third longest-running show in Broadway history and the highest grossing Broadway production of all time. Arranger Jay Bocook creates an exciting medley of songs from this Tony Award winning musical, including: "Circle of Life", "I Just Can't Wait to be King", "Can You Feel the Love Tonight", "Hakuna Matata", "They Live in You", and "King of Pride Rock".

That's Entertainment – A medley arranged by Warren Barker, "That's Entertainment" is comprised of songs that are considered anthems for Hollywood. They are also staple soundtrack elements of any Academy Awards ceremony. This piece includes: "Another Op'nin', Another Show" from *Kiss Me, Kate*; "Let Me Entertain You" from *Gypsy*; and "That's Entertainment" from *The Band Wagon*.
